Where should I report for volunteering?

All volunteers scheduled for Friday and Saturday (NOT Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday) should first check-in at the Engineering Council Office at 103C Engineering Hall. Volunteers scheduled for Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday night, and Sunday must go straight to their volunteering location. People who have not signed up to volunteer are more than welcome to walk in and we will attempt to place you at an open location if a spot is available. When you show up for a volunteer assignment, make sure that someone checks you in AND checks you out. This will ensure that your volunteer hours are recorded.

Are there any positions that require multiple hours of volunteering?

Yes! There are a few positions that we would rather you to volunteer for multiple hours. These are MRDC (as it requires a little training) and the design competitions (as you will be helping to run the competition and acting as a judge). These positions are marked on the website with a description that says you are encouraged to sign up for multiple hours.

Where do I get my shirt from if I did not volunteer on Friday or Saturday?

We appreciate all your support and help! If you volunteered Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday you can stop by 103C Engineering Hall on Friday or Saturday during exhibiting hours to pick up your free shirt!

How do I see who from my organization has volunteered for what?

The president of your society, as on file with Engineering Council, will have access to a special “My Society” tab in the application where they can see all of the people who have signed up for a slot in the organization(s) that they are the president of.
